C. CONSTITUTION

1. NAME AND PURPOSES

Article 1 Under the name "Uprising Cricket Club (UCC)" an association has been founded in compliance with Articles 60 to 79 of the Swiss Civil Code. The provisions of the Swiss Civil Code shall apply to the Association.

Article 2 The seat of the Association shall be in Geneva

Article 3 The purposes of the Association shall be to promote cricket in all its forms and to help set standards of quality ensuring a fairplay sport environment and providing equal access to all interested in cricket.

Article 4 The purposes of the Association are exclusively of public general interest. UCC is a sporting and non-profit organisation, independent and neutral on the subjects of race, religion, colour, creed and politics.

II. MEMBERSHIP

Article 5 The association is composed of two memberships:

5.1 *Full Members* - This category includes all players who shall enjoy a broad range of facilities and benefits and can attend all training and be available for all matches by paying subscription fees for membership. Those members will also have the right to vote at General Meetings, can be nominated to the Executive Committee and can propose candidates for future membership..

5.2 *Honorary members* - the Executive Committee can nominate honorary membership, adults supporters and contributors who take an active part in the well being of the Association and the promotion of cricket. They do not have the right of vote but may participate at the General Meetings with a consultative vote.

Article 6 The Executive Committee shall decide, by simple majority of those present and voting on admission of new members and continuance of membership.
